Dinner Money

If paying by cheque please make it payable to Edwards and Ward Ltd. **Dinner money must not get in arrears and you will be asked to change to a packed lunch if this happens.**

If your child wishes to change to school dinners from packed lunch or vice versa, please inform the school office. The exact number of lunches are cooked daily, therefore the school office needs to know exactly who is having a packed lunch or cooked school dinner.
