## Dinner Money

Just a reminder, dinner money is now £2.30 per day - £11.50 per week. Dinner money can be paid by the half term or weekly on a Monday morning. The amount required for this half term is £80.50 and payment can be made by cash or cheque in school via your child or by the on-line payment service. If paying by cheque please make it payable to Edwards and Ward Ltd.

**Dinner money must not get in arrears and you will be asked to change to a packed lunch if this happens.**

If your child wishes to change to school dinners from packed lunch or vice versa, please inform the school office. The exact number of lunches are cooked daily, therefore the school office needs to know exactly who is having a packed lunch or cooked school dinner.
