Could we also remind parents to ensure that all your child(ren)'s clothing and belongings are labelled (i.e. school uniform, PE kit, coats, lunchboxes). This can help us to return items to their owners as we have had a large amount of unnamed lost property recently.

### Contact Tracing – Christmas Holidays

Over the Christmas break, if anyone in your household has a positive COVID test, then please inform the school immediately. If you, your child, or a member of your household need to go for a test you should contact the school, and again when you receive your results.

Should the results be positive the school will continue to contact families to inform them of a child's need to isolate, following the UK government guidance.

Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, then you must follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.
