

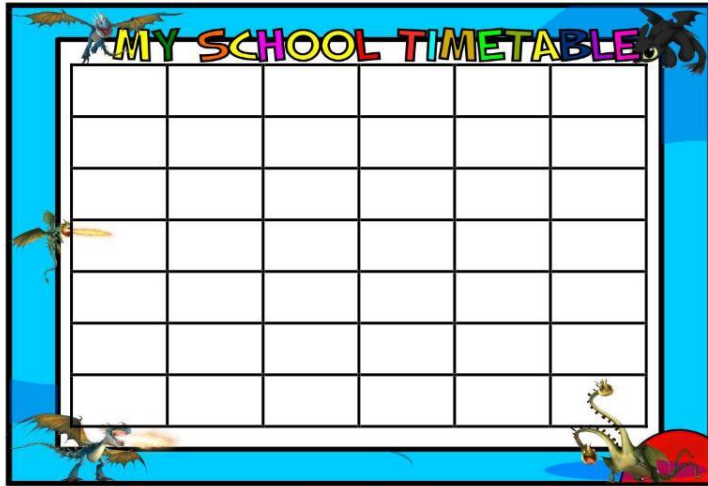

2.30 – 3.15 – Session 5

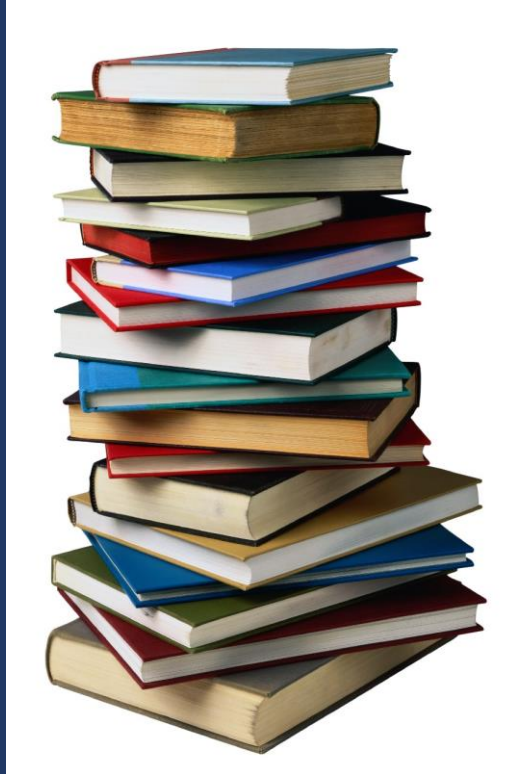




## PE

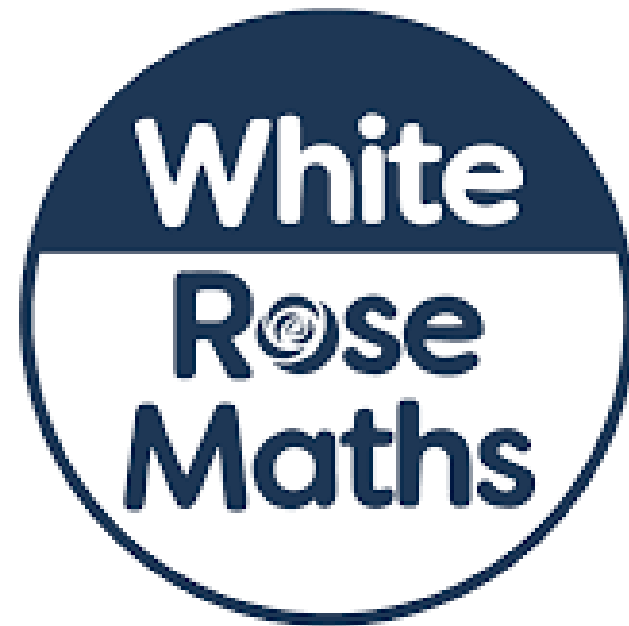
