Year 6 visit to Houses of Parliament Monday 2nd October

We hope that our Year 6 students have a great day visiting the Houses of Parliament on Monday 2nd October. Please drop your child off at Ash Vale station **promptly by 9:20am** so that we are ready for the 9:39am train to depart.

Please ensure that your child is sent to the station that day in full school uniform and a coat if the weather is cold or wet. Your child will need to bring a packed lunch with them which needs to be in a small backpack as they will be required to carry their belongings around with them at all times

We will be on a later train, **returning to Ash Vale station at 18:40**. Please pick up your child from the station at this time. If the time of arrival back changes, we will inform you. The visit will give them a valuable insight into the workings of Parliament which will benefit your child as they take on responsibilities during their time in Year 6.

School Absences

As part of the school's safeguarding arrangements, the School Office will call to explore reasons for absence from 9:30am onwards. The School Office will also issue text messages from lunchtime onwards if we have not been able to contact you. It is vital for school to know where the children are and when they will return to school.
