School Absences

Please can we ask that parents/carers report absence through the correct channels. This is to keep registers accurate and make sure that all children are safe. If your child is going to be absent from school due to illness or other circumstances, please ensure that you either call the school office or send a message via ParentMail. As part of the school's safeguarding arrangements, the School Office will call to explore reasons for absence from 9:30am onwards. The School Office will also issue text messages from lunchtime onwards if we have not been able to contact you. It is vital for school to know where the children are and when they will return to school.

Named Uniform

Please could you ensure that your child(ren)'s uniform is named, including PE Kits and coats. This usually ensures items do not end up in lost property.
