Attendance - Holidays in Term Time

I am writing to remind you that absence from school can only be authorised in exceptional circumstances and family holidays are not considered by Surrey County Council to be an exceptional circumstance.



If you wish to take your child out of school for exceptional reasons you will need to notify the school using our 'Leave of Absence in Exceptional Circumstances' form at least two weeks before the absence and you will be informed as to whether the absence can be authorised.

The national expectation is that children attend 100% of sessions the school is open.

Unauthorised absences of 5 days or more will result in a penalty notice and fine being issued by Surrey County Council. Penalty notices and fines will also be issued to parents whose child's attendance generally falls below 90%

Open Mornings

Due to a high demand for tours, we have added more open mornings dates for parents whose children are due to start primary school in September 2024 to visit the school. These visits give prospective parents the opportunity to have a tour of all the classrooms and an informal talk from leaders about Shawfield.

We are pleased to advise that the Inclusion Health Team in Surrey (who work with the Gypsy, Roma, Traveller (GRT) communities across Surrey) are running a GRT family drop in clinic at the Ash Vale Health Centre.

The clinic has been requested by members of the community in the Ash Vale area as a way for families to access health care from specialist GRT health visitors and community nursery nurses. At the clinic we offer services such as weighing and measuring the height of children, developmental reviews, blood pressure for adults and we can answer any concerns families may have about anything health related for their children (of any ages).
