#### Message from Headteacher

We have a very busy term ahead with a number of trips and visits organised to enhance the children's learning.

May I take this opportunity to remind families about the importance of children arriving to school on time.

Towards the end of last term, the number of children coming to school late via the School Office was noticeable. We know this greatly impacts the children and their readiness to learn. Equally, where children arrive consistently after 9am, they are U-coded which will impact their attendance figures. The Local Authority may issue fixed penalty notices to parents where attendance at school is not consistent and falls below expectation.
