Dear Parents and Carers,

Coronavirus Update

Further to my letter dated 10th March, the school continues to follow the UK Government and Public Health England advice, which is that school's should remain open. This advice is continually being updated. As part of our ongoing measures we are increasing our hand washing routines in line with the guidance.

As a reminder, if your child is showing symptoms of high temperature or a new, continuous cough (this means they've started coughing repeatedly) then they are advised to self-isolate for 7 days. You do not need to contact 111 to tell them that they are staying at home. Testing for coronavirus is not needed if they're staying at home. However, if you feel that they cannot cope with symptoms at home, or their condition gets worse, or they are not better after 7 days then you are advised to use the 111 coronavirus services, which can be accessed online via <https://111.nhs.uk/covid-19/>

Concern about coronavirus is high, but the risk to children seems to be low. So far, most reported cases of coronavirus have been in adults.

Children who do get it seem to have milder infections than adults or older people.
