### World Book Day Activities

World Book Day is taking place on Thursday 6th March, but leading up to the day we will be arranging various activities and below gives details of what will be taking place:

#### Potato Character

We are inviting children to create a character from a favourite book using a **potato** as your base! You can use anything you wish to decorate your potato, the more inventive the better! You could use paint, fabric, lollipop sticks, anything! We can't wait to see what ideas you come up with.

These should be sent your child's class email address **by Monday 3rd March**.

As well as this, there will be an interclass game where your children are invited to wear a mask of any kind and read a short extract from a book they enjoy, no longer than 15 seconds.
